3 March 1, 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, After graduating from Liberty Hill High School in  
5 1939, Pete Kauffman attended Southwest Texas State College, where  
6 he played on the Bobcats football team; he married his high school  
7 sweetheart, Nell, in 1941, and he and his wife became the proud  
8 parents of three children, Jim Kauffman, Rebecca Kauffman Pfiester,  
9 and Al Kauffman; today their fine family has grown to include seven  
10 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren; Pete and Nell Kauffman  
11 shared a rewarding relationship until her passing; and

12 WHEREAS, A farmer and rancher for 70 years, Mr. Kauffman was  
13 named Outstanding Agriculturist of Williamson County in 1975; his  
14 love of the land and his interest in encouraging young people who  
15 hope to pursue a similar vocation are reflected in the two \$5,000  
16 Pete and Nell Kauffman Scholarships that are awarded annually by  
17 the Williamson County A&M Club; the grants are intended for  
18 students from Liberty Hill High School and Georgetown High School  
19 who plan to study agriculture or land use at Texas A&M University;

21 WHEREAS, Deeply interested in the welfare of his community,  
22 this esteemed gentleman has played an active role over the years in  
23 a host of community endeavors and organizations; his many  
24 contributions in this arena have included service as a member of the

3 inspiration to his family and numerous friends, and it is a pleasure
