8 WHEREAS, This same vision and commitment to service has led 9 BCFS to become a key partner with the State of Texas during times of 10 emergency, such as Hurricanes Katrina, Rita, Dolly, Gustav, Ike, 11 and Alex, as well as in response to the H1N1 flu virus and the FLDS 12 incident in West Texas; and

13 WHEREAS, Whether at home in Texas, in Haiti following the 14 2010 earthquake, or in Sri Lanka following the 2004 tsunami, the 15 emergency management and response expertise of BCFS has always 16 sprung into action whenever called on; and

17 WHEREAS, In addition to responding to crises, the organization serves adults with intellectual or developmental 18 disabilities at a campus where they can gain the skills necessary to 19 20 thrive as part of their community; moreover, BCFS provides comfort 21 to young victims of abuse or neglect, counseling for those who are struggling with tragedy or trauma, medical treatment for the 22 23 impoverished, guidance for youth who lack families or support networks as they transition into adulthood, and help for those 24
