1           WHEREAS, Robert M. Terrill is retiring as constable for  
2 Precinct 4 of Kerr County on March 31, 2011, drawing to a close a  
3 notable career in public service that has spanned nearly a quarter  
4 of a century; and

5           WHEREAS, In 1977, after serving his nation at home and  
6 overseas as a member of the U.S. Army for 20 years, Bob Terrill  
7 became a peace officer; he worked for Texas A&M University at  
8 Galveston and for the cities of Montgomery and Taylor Lake Village  
9 before being appointed to complete an unexpired term as Kerr County  
10 constable in 1991; and

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Terrill went on to serve as deputy constable  
12 from 1993 to 2001, when he won election as constable; along the way,  
13 he earned the respect and admiration of his constituents, who twice  
14 reelected him to the post; and

15           WHEREAS, A skilled outdoorsman, Mr. Terrill has hunted and  
16 fished on three continents and is a talented hunting guide; he  
17 enjoyed the love and support of his wife, Gertrude, for 48 years,  
18 until her passing in 2008; and

19           WHEREAS, Bob Terrill's dedication, professionalism, and  
20 commitment to public safety have greatly benefited the citizens of  
21 Kerr County, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a career well  
22 spent as he embarks on the next exciting chapter of his life; now,  
23 therefore, be it
