## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, An estimated 10 million people in the United States 2 and millions of people worldwide have been diagnosed with 3 fibromyalgia, a disease for which there is no cure and the causes of 4 which are not fully understood; and

5 WHEREAS, Fibromyalgia is a chronic condition characterized 6 by widespread pain in muscles, ligaments, and tendons, as well as 7 fatigue and multiple tender points; although diagnoses of 8 fibromyalgia are becoming increasingly common, it can take multiple 9 consultations and as long as five years to receive a diagnosis 10 because medical professionals are often inadequately educated on 11 the disease; and

12 WHEREAS, Manifested through myriad symptoms that can come and 13 unpredictably and vary in severity, fibromyalgia qo is 14 life-altering; people with fibromyalgia are never completely symptom free, compromising their ability to work and to engage in 15 16 numerous activities, and this takes a toll emotionally, financially, and socially on those who suffer from the disease, as 17 well as on their family and friends; and 18

WHEREAS, Receiving an accurate diagnosis and information is the first step toward better managing the disease, and to this end, the National Fibromyalgia Association, Austin Fibro Friends, and other groups around the country are joining together to promote enhanced education, diagnosis, research, and treatment; and

24 WHEREAS, Increasing public understanding of fibromyalgia is

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1 essential to helping lessen the human and financial cost of this 2 disease, and participating in Fibromyalgia Awareness Month is one 3 way to support this effort; now, therefore, be it

Month and encourage all Texans to learn more about this chronic pain
disorder.

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
