R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The archers of the Canton High School A Team claimed
2 the school's second consecutive state title with a victory at the
3 championship tournament on February 25, 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, Two different Canton squads took part in the state
5 competition, and the Eagles' A Team scored a total of 3,217 points
6 to best second-place winner Argyle High, a previous three-time
7 state champion; the Canton B Team also turned in a fine performance
8 to finish in third with a total score of 3,166; with their triumph
9 in the tournament, the Canton archers qualified to take part in the
10 National Tournament in Louisville, Kentucky, and they will also
11 compete in the Texas/Oklahoma Shootout in Sherman; and

12 WHEREAS, The top male shooters in the competition were Chance
13 Wallace, Roy Denbow, and Seth Carroll, while Kaylie Robertson, Codi
14 Tutt, and Jaci Heard led the females; Ms. Robertson placed third in
15 the individual standings at state to win a scholarship from the
16 Texas Parks and Wildlife Department; and

17 WHEREAS, Under the skillful guidance of Coach Danny
18 Yarbrough, the Eagles dominated their opponents in all three
19 invitation meets of the season, scoring victories at Union Grove,
20 Flower Mound, and Ennis; since winning the 2010 title in its first
21 year of competition, Canton's team has built its fan base and gained
22 numerous members, enabling it to field two full squads of 24
23 students each; and

24 WHEREAS, The two state titles attained by the Canton High

1 archers are a testament to their talent, hard work, and dedication,
2 and they are a source of great pride to their school and their many
3 supporters in the community; now, therefore, be it
