1 WHEREAS, The certain knowledge of a life well lived may
2 temper the profound sadness felt at the passing of Mary Sykora of
3 West on March 1, 2011, at the age of 94; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on March 8, 1916, in Abbott, the daughter of
5 Frank and Mary Janda Adamcik, the former Mary Adamcik attended the
6 Ross School and St. Mary's School in West; she married Henry J.
7 Sykora in 1935, at a ceremony held in West, and the couple became
8 the parents of a son, Leonard; Mary and Henry Sykora shared a
9 rewarding relationship that spanned 30 years, until Mr. Sykora's
10 death in 1965; through the years, Mrs. Sykora rejoiced in seeing her
11 family grow to include three more generations; and

12 WHEREAS, In addition to taking care of her loved ones and her
13 home, Mrs. Sykora worked for the Hyatt Hotels Corporation in Dallas
14 for 15 years, and she was employed as a dental assistant for more
15 than a quarter-century; she also went into business for herself as a
16 beauty consultant for Mary Kay; and

17 WHEREAS, Strongly rooted in her religious and cultural
18 heritage, Mary Sykora was a congregant of St. Mary Catholic Church
19 of the Assumption and a member of the Catholic Daughters of the
20 Americas Court No. 829, as well as a member of KJZT Society No. 11,
21 SPJST Lodge No. 54, and the Czech Women's Organization; in her
22 leisure time, she enjoyed entertaining, cooking, and sewing; and

23 WHEREAS, Mary Sykora lived a rich and purposeful life, and
24 those who were privileged to share in her love and friendship will

1 forever remember her with great tenderness and affection; now,
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Mary Sykora and
5 extend sincere sympathy to the members of her family: to her
6 daughter-in-law, Joy Sykora; to her granddaughter, Mary Faye
