23 given generously of his time and expertise to Texans in need of

24 legal representation, and he has been a member of the Pro Bono

- 3 commitment to his community; he is an Eagle Scout and continues to
- 4 be active in the Boy Scouts of America, and he has served on the

- 7 he has received numerous accolades, and the University of North
- 8 Texas presented him with the Green Glory Award and named him an
- 9 Outstanding Alumnus of the School of Political Science; and
