2 basketball team made school history by becoming the first squad  
3 from that institution to reach the Final Four of the Texas  
4 Association of Private and Parochial Schools 2A playoffs; and

20 Fischer Hoisington, Adam Mueller, Santiago Paredes, Zachary  
21 Rosanova, and Evan St. Angelo; and

22           WHEREAS, The talented and dedicated student-athletes of the  
23 Austin Waldorf School basketball team are a source of great pride  
24 for their many supporters, and their exceptional performance on the

1 court is indeed deserving of special recognition; now, therefore,
