R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The 2010-2011 Austin Waldorf School boys'
2 basketball team made school history by becoming the first squad
3 from that institution to reach the Final Four of the Texas
4 Association of Private and Parochial Schools 2A playoffs; and

7 district opponents and had an overall record of 34-6; the average
8 margin of victory in the team's wins was more than 28 points per
