1           WHEREAS, Lloyd Jenkins is retiring as president of the Plano  
2 Independent School District Board of Trustees on May 17, 2011,  
3 concluding his third term of distinguished service; and

4           WHEREAS, First elected in 2002, "Skip" Jenkins served the  
5 Plano ISD board as secretary from 2005 to 2008 and was then elected  
6 president by his fellow trustees for three consecutive years; he  
7 earned the designation of Master Trustee from the Texas Association  
8 of School Boards and is a graduate of Leadership TASB and a charter  
9 Fellow of the Center for Reform of School Systems; dedicated to  
10 improving public schools, Mr. Jenkins has served two terms as  
11 president of the Plano ISD Education Foundation as well; and

12           WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan has demonstrated his deep  
13 commitment to his community in numerous ways through the years; the  
14 former president of the Plano Rotary Club, he has also served his  
15 Rotary district as vocational service chair and as a board member  
16 and counselor for the organization's youth leadership training  
17 program; in addition, he has been a director of the Plano Children's  
18 Medical Clinic and is a graduate of Leadership Plano and the Plano  
19 Citizen's Police Academy; moreover, the Leadership Plano executive  
20 board gave him its Distinguished Leadership Award in 2005 and  
21 *Inside Collin County Business* named him one of "21 Leaders for the  
22 21st Century"; and

23           WHEREAS, A certified public accountant, Mr. Jenkins has been  
24 a respected member of the Plano business community for more than

1 three decades; he holds a bachelor's degree in accounting and a  
2 master's degree in finance from Michigan State University; and

3 WHEREAS, Skip Jenkins has greatly benefited Plano ISD through  
4 his skill, professionalism, and expertise, and by devoting himself  
5 to the cause of public education, he has earned the admiration and  
6 gratitude of his fellow citizens; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
8 Legislature hereby congratulate Lloyd "Skip" Jenkins on the  
9 occasion of his retirement from the Plano Independent School  
10 District and extend to him sincere best wishes for success in his  
11 future endeavors; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
13 prepared for Mr. Jenkins as an expression of high regard by the  
14 Texas House of Representatives.
