2 in Georgetown has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this  
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

16 junior at Georgetown High School and a valued member of the school  
17 band as well as Christ Lutheran Church; he plans to attend college  
18 and pursue a career as a graphic artist and web designer; and

19           WHEREAS, This outstanding young Texan's achievements are all  
20 the more impressive given that he successfully overcame a battle  
21 with leukemia five years ago; he has since been involved in a number  
22 of charitable endeavors in behalf of cancer research; and

23           WHEREAS, The dedication to excellence and perseverance in the  
24 pursuit of his goals that Mr. Gingras has demonstrated have proven

1 him worthy to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed  
2 reflect with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
4 Legislature hereby congratulate Sean Gingras on achieving the rank  
5 of Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued  
6 success and happiness; and, be it further
