2 tenure as chair of the Texas Christian University Board of Trustees
3 in 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. King has been a valued member of the board since
5 2005, and during his distinguished tenure his efforts have played a
6 vital role in the success of the school, which was named one of the
7 Top 20 Up-and-Coming National Universities by *U.S. News & World*
8 *Report* in 2010; and

9 WHEREAS, A chartered financial analyst, Mr. King is the
10 president and founder of the registered investment advisory firm
11 Luther King Capital Management Corporation; through his company, he
12 established the LKCM Center for Financial Studies at the TCU Neeley
13 School of Business, and he has also offered internship
14 opportunities for more than 100 finance and accounting majors; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. King and his wife, Teresa, have further
16 benefited Texas Christian University by underwriting several
17 facilities and by providing support for athletics, the Ranch
18 Management Program, and scholarships; and

19 WHEREAS, Respected in his field, Mr. King has served as chair
20 of the Investment Adviser Association board and the Investment
21 Advisory Committee for the Employees Retirement System of Texas; in
22 addition, he has been vice chair of the board of The University of
23 Texas Investment Management Company, which has responsibilities
24 for the endowment of The University of Texas and a portion of the

1 endowment for Texas A&M University; and

2 WHEREAS, This esteemed professional has earned a number of
3 honors for his work, including the title of Most Inspiring from *CFA*
4 *Magazine* and the Daniel J. Forrestal III Leadership Award for
5 Professional Ethics & Standards of Investment Practice from the CFA
6 Institute; and

7 WHEREAS, Texas Christian University has greatly benefited
8 from the dedication and expertise that Luther King has brought to
9 his role as chair of the board of trustees, and his commitment to
10 the institution has furthered its mission of preparing students for
11 the future; now, therefore, be it

13 Legislature hereby commend J. Luther King, Jr., for his service as
14 chair of the Texas Christian University Board of Trustees and
