## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Taylor Levy of Wichita Falls won first place in the 2010-2011 Texas Veterans of Foreign Wars Voice of Democracy essay competition; and

WHEREAS, A 17-year-old senior at S. H. Rider High School, Ms. Levy was chosen over nearly 2,000 other Texas high school students for her entry about the challenges facing her generation; she argues in her essay that, for all their differences with earlier generations, young people today share the innately American values of a strong work ethic, ingenuity, and unity of spirit that will enable them to play an important part in the continuing progress of our nation; and
