

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Rogelio Hernandez Musquiz of Del Rio retired in 2010
2 after a notable 12-year tenure as a Val Verde County commissioner;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Del Rio, Roy Musquiz graduated from
5 Howard Payne University in 1967 and earned a master's degree in
6 education from Sul Ross State University in 1972; he began his
7 career as an educator in 1967, when he was hired by the San Felipe
8 Del Rio school district to teach elementary school; he went on to
9 become a counselor and an assistant principal, and in 1982 he was
10 appointed principal, a post he held for 16 years until his
11 retirement from education in 1998; along the way, he served the
12 greater community as a Del Rio Housing Authority commissioner and
13 as a precinct chair; moreover, he was a member of the Del Rio City
14 Council from 1990 to 1997; and

15 WHEREAS, In 1998, Mr. Musquiz was elected to the Val Verde
16 County Commissioners Court, and during his time in office, he
17 helped to oversee a number of significant community improvements;
18 construction began on new roadways, many older streets were paved,
19 street lights were installed at school bus stops, a local detention
20 center was expanded, and a facility was built for the Cienegas
21 community to provide classes, medical services, and a food bank; in
22 addition, Mr. Musquiz was instrumental in the creation of a park
23 east of Del Rio, which was later named in his honor; and

24 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan is a life member of the Del Rio

1 San Felipe Lions Club, and he served the organization as its
2 president; he further distinguished himself as a member of the
3 board of the San Felipe Ex-Student Memorial Center for three years;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Musquiz enjoys the love
6 and support of his wife of 50 years, Maria, and their two children,
7 Rogelio and Julissa; and

8 WHEREAS, Roy Musquiz has made important and lasting
9 contributions to Val Verde County, and he can indeed take pride in
10 his myriad accomplishments as he looks forward to the next exciting
11 chapter in his life; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
13 Legislature hereby honor Rogelio Hernandez Musquiz on his
14 retirement as a member of the Val Verde County Commissioners Court
15 and extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it
16 further

17 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
18 prepared for Mr. Musquiz as an expression of high regard by the
19 Texas House of Representatives.
