9 WHEREAS, A strong supporter of civic and arts organizations, Mr. Bussey contributed to educational institutions such as Paul 10 Quinn College, Wiley College, and St. Philip's School and Community 11 12 Center, as well as to the Urban League of Greater Dallas and North Central Texas, the Black Academy of Arts and Letters, and the March 13 14 of Dimes; through the Sam and Ruth Bussey Foundation, he and his wife donated to the Dallas Black Dance Theatre and other groups, and 15 16 he was recognized for his generosity by the Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Center, the African American Museum Dallas, and the 17 Dallas Regional Chamber of Commerce; and 18

WHEREAS, Mr. Bussey enjoyed gardening and playing dominoes in his free time; a member of Riverside Missionary Baptist Church for a half-century, he also served as an usher there; and

22 WHEREAS, In addition to his wife, Ruth, with whom he shared 64 23 years, Mr. Bussey's family included five children, Milton, 24 Anthony, Beverly, Ladine, and the late Larry Bussey, who preceded
