1 WHEREAS, Gerald Brown, a retired lieutenant with the Dallas
2 Fire-Rescue Department, has rendered exceptional service as chair
3 of the Dallas Police and Fire Pension System Board of Trustees; and

4 WHEREAS, Elected to the board in 1983, Jerry Brown was chosen
5 as board chair in 1999, and he served in that capacity for 11 years;
6 with his retirement from the Dallas Fire-Rescue Department on
7 August 31, 2010, he stepped down as head of the board, but he
8 remained a trustee until March 2011, when a special election was
9 held to fill his seat; and

10 WHEREAS, During his tenure at the helm, Mr. Brown provided
11 the board with confident, steady guidance as it oversaw a period of
12 successful financial growth; known for his good humor and his
13 tireless determination to expand his expertise, he became the
14 organization's real estate expert as it added more properties to
15 its investment portfolio; he also served on the board's
16 administrative advisory committee; and

17 WHEREAS, In addition to working with the Dallas Police and
18 Fire Pension System, Mr. Brown has served as a vice president on the
19 board of directors for the Texas Association of Public Employee
20 Retirement Systems and as a member of the National Conference on
21 Public Employee Retirement Systems; and

22 WHEREAS, Through his knowledgeable and energetic leadership,
23 Jerry Brown has played an instrumental role in ensuring the
24 soundness of the Dallas police officers' and firefighters'
