1 WHEREAS, Father Joseph F. Geleney, Jr., of the Church of St. 2 Mary of the Assumption in Waco is commemorating the 10th 3 anniversary of his ordination as a Roman Catholic priest on June 16, 4 2011; and

11 WHEREAS, In 1997, he entered the seminary at Sacred Heart 12 School of Theology in Wisconsin, where he earned his master of divinity degree; ordained by Bishop Gregory M. Aymond in 2001, 13 Father Geleney began his first assignment as a priest in July of 14 that year as associate pastor at St. Thomas More Catholic Church in 15 16 Austin; four years later, he became assistant pastor at St. Albert the Great Catholic Church, also in Austin, and in 2007, he assumed 17 the responsibilities of pastor at two churches, St. Ann in 18 Somerville and Blessed Virgin Mary in Washington; and 19

20 WHEREAS, Father Geleney has served as pastor of the Church of 21 St. Mary of the Assumption in Waco since July 2010; his professional 22 areas of interest include scripture, liturgy, and youth ministry; 23 and
