WHEREAS, After beginning his career in banking, Mr. Dyer was named the assistant administrator for Obion County General Hospital at the age of 21; he moved to Texas in 1957 and became the assistant administrator of Providence Hospital in El Paso; for a brief time, he was employed by a CBS affiliate in El Paso and a UHF station in Dallas, but he returned to the medical field and managed clinics in Dallas and Marion as well as in Ohio and Kansas; and

WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan later served as administrator of Hillcrest Baptist Medical Center in Waco and opened several clinics for the center before his retirement in 1996; he and his wife also
