9 WHEREAS, Mr. Keller attended Texas A&M University before 10 serving his country as a member of the United States Navy; one 11 evening in San Antonio, he had the good fortune to meet a young 12 Canadian nurse on vacation, and less than a year later, he and the 13 former Janet Hayes were married; the couple were blessed with five 14 children, Michael, Mark, John, Laura, and Kathryn, and with the 15 passing decades, the family grew to include 10 grandchildren; and

16 WHEREAS, For many years, Mr. Keller ran Mason County Farm 17 Bureau Insurance, and it was widely known that his word was his 18 bond; he greatly enjoyed working as a guide during hunting season 19 and relished the camaraderie he shared with his fellow guides; and

20 WHEREAS, In 2000, he was ordained as a deacon and began 21 serving the members of St. Joseph Parish by performing baptisms, 22 weddings, funerals, and other duties; and
