

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Sacred Heart Catholic School in Del Rio  
2 celebrated the 110th anniversary of its establishment in 2010; and

3           WHEREAS, Thought to be the oldest educational institution in  
4 the Del Rio area, Sacred Heart Catholic School was founded in 1900,  
5 and since that time, it has provided a quality education to  
6 generations of children from the region; and

7           WHEREAS, Under the able guidance of principal Aurora Guerra  
8 and assistant principal Julie Ricks, Sacred Heart has been  
9 recognized as an official "Leader In Me School," a program in which  
10 children from prekindergarten through eighth grade are taught  
11 leadership, accountability, self-direction, responsibility,  
12 problem solving, and other skills; and

13           WHEREAS, Sacred Heart junior high students chose the historic  
14 Loma De La Cruz Cemetery in Del Rio as their service project; they  
15 worked with the Loma De La Cruz Cemetery Association in helping with  
16 the preservation of the site and in recording and updating  
17 information about the people buried there; moreover, on February  
18 25, 2011, students joined with alumni and other community  
19 volunteers to clean up the cemetery as part of the nationwide  
20 celebration of Catholic Schools Week; and

21           WHEREAS, For more than 11 decades, the faculty and staff of  
22 Sacred Heart Catholic School have committed themselves to meeting  
23 the educational needs of their students, and the school has played a  
24 vital role in helping many young Texans build a bright and

2           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
3 Legislature hereby commemorate the 110th anniversary of Sacred  
4 Heart Catholic School and extend to all those associated with the
