11 with her husband, Milton, until his passing in 2010; the couple made
12 their home in Allentown, Pennsylvania, for many years, and Mrs.

15 became valued members of the Shepherd Christian Community and the
16 Maranatha Baptist Retirement Community; and

17 WHEREAS, Devoted to her faith, Mrs. Pruitt was a Sunday
18 school teacher and worked with her church's high school youth
19 group; moreover, she wrote articles on the topic of childhood
20 evangelism; and

21 WHEREAS, Although Maureen Pruitt will be greatly missed, she
22 will forever be remembered with deep affection by all who held her
23 close to their hearts; now, therefore, be it
