RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The San Antonio Water System has been named the 2 winner of a 2011 Texas Environmental Excellence Award in the 3 innovative operations/management category; and

WHEREAS, Each spring the Texas Environmental Excellence 4 5 Awards are presented to individuals, communities, organizations, and businesses that have created successful programs to preserve 6 7 and protect the environment of the Lone Star State; nominated by a blue ribbon committee and selected by the Office of the Governor and 8 9 the commissioners of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, 10 the award winners have made outstanding contributions to the effort to prevent pollution, reduce waste, and conserve natural resources; 11 12 and

WHEREAS, The San Antonio Water System was recognized for its 13 Wastewater Trifecta, a project to develop environmentally 14 beneficial uses for the water, biosolids, and waste gas that are the 15 16 major by-products of the city's wastewater treatment process; as part of the project, SAWS developed the largest direct recycled 17 water delivery system in the nation--a network of more than 110 18 miles of pipeline that delivers treated, recycled water for 19 20 commercial and industrial use; the high-quality water is also used 21 to help restore streams and aquatic ecosystems in the city; and

22 WHEREAS, The second part of the Trifecta involves turning the 23 organic matter produced at wastewater treatment plants into compost 24 that is used by landscapers and gardeners to improve soil quality;

in 2009, 98 percent of the organic material produced was recycled as compost; SAWS has also succeeded in recycling the methane gas that is generated from the biosolids; once simply burned off into the atmosphere, the gas is now refined in such a way that it becomes chemically identical to natural gas, and it is then transferred to a commercial pipeline for distribution as fuel for heating and cooking; and

8 WHEREAS, In addition to establishing the Wastewater Trifecta, SAWS has created numerous other programs and community 9 10 outreach campaigns to promote water conservation, and the cumulative effect of its efforts has been to lower the amount of 11 12 water used in the city each day; less water use has meant reduced water pumping, which has helped to protect the Edwards Aquifer and 13 14 to preserve habitats for endangered species; and

15 WHEREAS, By developing conservation initiatives such as the 16 Wastewater Trifecta, the San Antonio Water System has demonstrated 17 that it is a good steward of its water resources, and it is indeed 18 deserving of this prestigious honor; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas 20 Legislature hereby congratulate the San Antonio Water System on 21 receiving a Texas Environmental Excellence Award and extend to all 22 those associated with the organization sincere best wishes for 23 continued success; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be prepared for SAWS as an expression of high regard by the Texas House of Representatives.
