1 WHEREAS, Dr. Larry R. Kaiser concluded his tenure as 2 president of The University of Texas Health Science Center at 3 Houston on April 1, 2011, and it is indeed fitting to honor him for a 4 job well done; and

5 WHEREAS, Since becoming the fifth president of UTHealth in 2008, Dr. Kaiser worked tirelessly to enhance the stature of the 6 7 health science center and its partners in the Texas Medical Center, guiding the launch of the UTHealth brand and continuing to 8 9 strengthen the relationship with Memorial Hermann Healthcare System, the Harris County Hospital District, and other institutions 10 in the Texas Medical Center; during his tenure, UTHealth was named a 11 12 top workplace by the Houston Chronicle; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kaiser held the Alkek-Williams Chair and served 13 14 as a professor of surgery and of cardiothoracic and vascular surgery at the university; moreover, he demonstrated a commitment 15 16 to the community as a member of the boards of the Greater Houston Partnership, Memorial Hermann Healthcare System, BioHouston, the 17 Houston Technology Center, the Texas Heart Institute, the John P. 18 McGovern Museum of Health & Medical Science, and the American Heart 19 Association in Houston; he chaired the 2009-2010 Houston March of 20 21 Dimes March for Babies Walk as well; and

22 WHEREAS, This esteemed surgeon and dynamic executive earned 23 his medical degree from Tulane University and performed his 24 internship and surgical residency at the University of California

1 at Los Angeles; completing his education in thoracic and 2 cardiovascular surgery, he served as senior resident in thoracic 3 surgery at the University of Toronto; he then joined the faculty on 4 the Thoracic Service at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center and 5 was recruited in 1988 by Washington University School of Medicine, 6 where he rose to become an associate professor; and

7 WHEREAS, Before joining UTHealth, Dr. Kaiser distinguished 8 himself at the University of Pennsylvania as associate professor of surgery, chief of general thoracic surgery, founder and director of 9 10 the Lung Transplantation Program, and director of the Center for Lung Cancer and Related Disorders; he is a pioneer in the technique 11 12 of video thoracoscopy, for which he designed and patented a set of instruments; elected to the Institute of Medicine of the National 13 14 Academies of Science in 2005, he is the recipient of numerous 15 accolades; he has published more than 250 original papers and authored or coauthored more than a dozen books, and he serves on the 16 17 editorial boards of the Annals of Surgery, Contemporary Surgery, ACS Surgery, and other notable publications; and 18

19 WHEREAS, A native of Philadelphia, Dr. Kaiser is returning to his hometown to become chief executive of the Temple University 20 Health System, senior executive vice president for Health Sciences, 21 and dean of the School of Medicine; as he begins his new 22 23 responsibilities at that prestigious institution, he may reflect 24 with pride on his contributions to The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston and the surrounding community; now, 25 26 therefore, be it
