6 Jr.; part of a pioneer Brewster County ranching family, he
7 eventually took over Woodward Ranch, which was recognized by the
8 Family Land Heritage Program in 1989; in addition to being a working
9 cattle ranch, Woodward is one of the few in the state open to the
10 public; in particular, it is a destination for rock collectors, and
11 Mr. Woodward delighted visitors with his knowledge of gems and
12 minerals; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Woodward was the father of two sons, Bobby
14 Williams-Woodward and the late Jay Woodward, and in 2002, he
15 married the former Jan Jayson, with whom he shared a loving
16 relationship; and

17 WHEREAS, Although Trey Woodward will be deeply missed, his
18 welcoming smile and passion for ranching will forever be remembered
19 by all those fortunate enough to have known him; now, therefore, be
