1 WHEREAS, After three rounds of outstanding play against
2 determined competition, The University of Texas at El Paso women's
3 golf team emerged victorious at the 2011 Conference USA
4 Championship, held at the Peninsula Golf and Racquet Club in Gulf
5 Shores, Alabama; and

6 WHEREAS, The three-day tournament began on April 17, and
7 after the first round the Miners were tied for first with Southern
8 Methodist University at 302; UTEP shot the same combined score the
9 next day to maintain a slim lead, and the team improved to 300 on the
10 third day for a total of 904; this was enough to top the runner-up
11 University of Tulsa golfers by two strokes; and

12 WHEREAS, Junior Teresa Nogues won the individual title and
13 was named to the All-Conference team, shooting a 71-75-72 for a two
14 over par total of 218; Rosana Gomez, who also earned All-Conference
15 honors, finished tied for fifth with a 224 and Shang-Fan Huang tied
16 for 12th with a 228; also contributing to the UTEP team effort were
17 Ana Pastor, who scored 238, and Liz Sobczak, who shot 248; and

18 WHEREAS, Under the skilled guidance of coach Jere Pelletier,
19 the Miners qualified for the NCAA Championship with their victory
20 in the conference tournament, and their achievement is a testament
21 to their countless hours of hard work and unwavering commitment to
22 excellence; now, therefore, be it
