1 WHEREAS, Created in 2002, the H-E-B Excellence in Education
2 Awards were established to honor outstanding public school
3 professionals and to thank them for their dedication and
4 commitment; and

5 WHEREAS, H-E-B seeks to pay tribute to those educators and
6 administrators who go the extra mile each and every day to serve
7 their students and their communities and who inspire others to do
8 the same; and

9 WHEREAS, Nominees for the awards submit applications
10 detailing their professional experiences, educational
11 philosophies, and achievements both inside and outside the
12 classroom; 40 individual statewide finalists are named from 5
13 regions, and 10 winners will ultimately be announced, including 2
14 principals, 6 teachers, and 1 large and 1 small school district; and

15 WHEREAS, Winning teachers will be named from both elementary
16 and secondary schools in categories recognizing those with less
17 than 10, between 10 and 20, and more than 20 years of classroom
18 experience; all winners will receive prizes worth thousands of
19 dollars for themselves and for their schools; and

20 WHEREAS, In addition, H-E-B has introduced a new awards
21 category this year, the Fit Campus Award, which will honor 10
22 campuses across the state that make special efforts to educate
23 children, parents, and staff members about the importance of health
24 and wellness; and

1 WHEREAS, In bestowing the Excellence in Education Awards,
2 H-E-B is recognizing the notable efforts of Texas educators who are
3 building the future of the Lone Star State by teaching our next
4 generation of leaders; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
6 Legislature hereby congratulate the 2011 recipients of the H-E-B
7 Excellence in Education Awards and extend to them sincere best
8 wishes for continued success; and, be it further
