1 WHEREAS, The Honorable Curt Henderson retired as senior state 2 district judge for the 219th Judicial District Court in October 2010, concluding a distinguished tenure in office that spanned a 3 quarter-century; and 4 5 WHEREAS, The longest-serving state jurist in Collin County history, Judge Henderson was appointed to the 219th Judicial 6 7 District to complete an unexpired term in 1988; at only 35, he was one of the youngest district judges in Texas; he was later elected a 8 9 total of seven times and presided over thousands of civil, family, and criminal cases, earning a reputation for diligence and 10 integrity; and

11 12 WHEREAS, Judge Henderson played a key role in the creation of the For Kids' Sake program, and he has served on the advisory board 13 14 of CASA of Collin County; moreover, he has worked diligently to encourage area lawyers to provide services to low-income Texans in 15 16 need of legal advice; he benefited his profession as chair of the State Bar of Texas Computer and Technology Committee and advocated 17 powerfully for the use of technology to improve court services; and 18 WHEREAS, In 2001, Judge Henderson received the Voice for 19 20 Children Award from CASA of Collin County; his many accolades also 21 include the Equal Justice Award from Legal Services of North Texas, the Atticus Finch Award from Collin County Legal Aid of Northwest 22 23 Texas, and the Lifetime Achievement in Technology Award from the Computer and Technology Section of the State Bar of Texas; and 24

- 1 WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan graduated from Texas A&M
- 2 University and Baylor University Law School; board certified in
- 3 criminal law, he served as an assistant criminal district attorney
- 4 in Collin County from 1979 to 1986; Judge Henderson was then
- 5 appointed as a Collin County court judge, and, in addition to his
- 6 regular duties, he was designated as presiding judge in Probate
- 7 Court and Mental Court; after joining the 219th Judicial District,
- 8 Judge Henderson was appointed to the Collin County Bail Bond Board
- 9 and served as vice chair; and
- 10 WHEREAS, A fellow of the Texas Bar Foundation, Judge
- 11 Henderson is also a fellow of the Collin County Bench Bar Foundation
- 12 and has served that organization in numerous leadership roles;
- 13 since his retirement, Judge Henderson has continued to serve the
- 14 judicial system as a senior district judge and a mediator and
- 15 arbitrator; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Judge Henderson has served the State of Texas with
- 17 great skill and dedication, earning the lasting respect of all who
- 18 were privileged to work with him, and his myriad good works have
- 19 made a lasting, positive difference in his community; now,
