- 9 that building was destroyed by arson, but the structure was later
- 10 replaced; the institution has continued to grow since that time,
- 11 expanding to a new facility across the street in 1982 and adding a
- 12 Family Life Center in 2001; and
- WHEREAS, Along the way, the church has benefited from the
- 14 dedicated efforts of a number of outstanding clergymen, including
- 15 Brother Jerry Norris, who leads the congregation today with the
- 16 assistance of his wife, Sister Johnnie Norris; and
- WHEREAS, United by their shared faith and strong traditions,
- 18 the members of this notable house of worship sponsor a variety of
- 19 commendable programs that offer fellowship as well as help to those
- 20 in need; in addition to caring for the homeless, the congregation
- 21 has supported missionaries, ministerial students, and the
