2 of Denise Short Smith of Plano, who passed away on March 21, 2010;

4 WHEREAS, Setting an outstanding example of civic engagement,
5 Ms. Smith was an active and valued member of the Republican Party;
6 in addition to her work as legislative chair of the Plano Republican
7 Women, she supported a number of candidates through the years,
8 including Van Taylor in his successful campaign for state
9 representative; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Smith was dedicated to giving back to our men and
11 women in the military, serving as a U.S. Air Force colonel's liaison
12 and facilitating support groups in a Red Cross/USAF joint health
13 initiative; she also shared her time to benefit her fellow

15 volunteer with George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate and Gardens
16 and the Heard Natural Science Museum and Wildlife Sanctuary; and

17 WHEREAS, A gifted writer, Ms. Smith returned to school later
18 in life to earn a master's degree in public relations and
19 journalism; she graduated magna cum laude from the University of
20 North Texas and was awarded many honors for her exceptional work;
21 the recipient of a Mayborn Writers Award, Outstanding Public
22 Relations/Journalism Student Award, and English Department
23 Faculty's Outstanding Student Award, she earned the Kenneth May
24 Scholarship and the President's Merit Scholarship as well as

1 placement on the Dean's List and President's List; in addition, she
2 was a member of the Kappa Tau Alpha National Honor Society and the
3 Phi Kappa Phi National Honor Society; and

4 WHEREAS, Denise Smith was a woman of rare determination and
5 passion who was engaged in her community throughout her life and who
6 found joy and inspiration in helping others; now, therefore, be it
