R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, H. E. "Gene" Crump, Jr., is retiring from his  
2 position as deputy executive director of the Texas Workforce  
3 Commission in May 2011, drawing to a close a notable career in  
4 public service that has spanned 35 years; and

5           WHEREAS, A graduate of the University of North Carolina, Mr.  
6 Crump earned master's degrees in financial management from the U.S.  
7 Naval Postgraduate School and in strategic studies from the U.S.  
8 Naval War College; and

9           WHEREAS, In 1976, he joined the Department of the Navy, and  
10 during his distinguished 18-year tenure, he served as comptroller  
11 for three naval installations, developing and executing budgets in  
12 excess of \$400 million; and

13           WHEREAS, Mr. Crump went on to work as a budget analyst and  
14 budget officer with the Texas General Services Commission, where he  
15 was promoted to the position of fiscal division director in 1997; he  
16 later brought his wealth of knowledge and experience to the Texas  
17 Workforce Commission, and as deputy executive director, he has  
18 assisted with the day-to-day operations of the agency while  
19 directing the departments that provide core internal services,  
20 including finance, human resources management, and business  
21 operations; and

22           WHEREAS, Gene Crump has demonstrated professionalism and  
23 dedication throughout his years with the Texas Workforce  
24 Commission, and he has earned the lasting respect of all who have

1 been privileged to work with him; now, therefore, be it

2           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
3 Legislature hereby honor H. E. "Gene" Crump, Jr., on his retirement  
4 as deputy executive director of the Texas Workforce Commission and  
5 extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

7 prepared for Mr. Crump as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
8 House of Representatives.
