1 WHEREAS, A full and generous life drew to a close with the
2 death of Stanley Louis Jahn of Waco on March 28, 2011, at the age of
3 80; and

4 WHEREAS, Stanley Jahn was born in San Antonio on September 8,
5 1930, to William H. and Martha Schindler Jahn; after graduating
6 from Waco Technical High School in 1948, he enlisted in the U.S. Air
7 Force and served as a photographic laboratory technician from 1949
8 to 1950; and

9 WHEREAS, Returning home, Mr. Jahn continued his military
10 service as a member of the Air Force Reserves, while also working
11 for a surveying company and a construction firm and completing a
12 four-year carpentry apprenticeship; he joined the Texas Highway
13 Department in 1956 and remained there for nearly two decades,
14 during which time he earned a degree in architecture from the
15 International Correspondence School and became a registered civil
16 engineer; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Jahn later founded the Jahn Company and, aside
18 from a stint with the City of Waco, ran the business until he
19 retired in 2006; he was a registered public surveyor and a member of
20 the American Society of Civil Engineers; and

21 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Jahn enjoyed the love
22 and support of his wife, Norma Jean Jahn, with whom he shared 57
23 years; they were the parents of three children, Phil Jahn, Tim Jahn,
24 and the late Karen Jahn Villers; and

1 WHEREAS, Stanley Jahn was a loving husband, a devoted father
2 and grandfather, and a true and loyal friend, and those who were
3 privileged to know him will long remember his bright blue eyes and
4 ready smile; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
6 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Stanley Louis Jahn and
7 extend sincere condolences to the members of his family: to his
8 wife, Norma Jean Jahn; to his sons, Phil Jahn and his wife, Cindy,

10 Hoag and her husband, Jared, Matthew Thomas Jahn and Tammara Cook,
