1           WHEREAS, A life made rich through meaningful service drew to  
2 a close with the passing of James Robert Morrow, Sr., of Elm Mott on  
3 April 4, 2011, at the age of 86; and

4           WHEREAS, James Morrow was born on October 18, 1924, in  
5 Trimble, Tennessee, to Elroy and Mamie Hornbeck Morrow; he attended  
6 school in Yorkville, Tennessee, before answering his nation's call  
7 to duty and enlisting in the U.S. Navy; he went on to build a  
8 distinguished 30-year military career that included service in  
9 World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War, and he retired at  
10 the rank of chief petty officer in 1970; he later ran a taxi service  
11 in Hanford, California; and

12           WHEREAS, Mr. Morrow shared more than six decades with his  
13 wife, the former Ethel Drake, whom he married in 1944 in Wesley,  
14 Rhode Island; together the couple were blessed with three children,  
15 Royce, Charles, and James, and they shared in the joy of welcoming  
16 numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren into their family;

18           WHEREAS, Throughout his life, Mr. Morrow took great pleasure  
19 in reading, traveling, and camping; moreover, he was a proud  
20 veteran who loved sharing stories of his time in the navy; and

21           WHEREAS, While his death has brought great sorrow to all who  
22 knew him, memories of James Morrow will be forever treasured by all  
23 who were privileged to share in his love and friendship; now,  
24 therefore, be it
