2 Perlman Harris, who passed away on April 2, 2011, at the age of 96;

4           WHEREAS, A native of the Lone Star State, the former Anne  
5 Perlman was born in Galveston on April 24, 1914, to Sam and Esther  
6 Perlman; after graduating as valedictorian of Ball High School, she  
7 earned her bachelor's degree with honors from The University of  
8 Texas and returned to Galveston to teach at her alma mater; and

9           WHEREAS, In 1941, she married Charles M. Harris, with whom  
10 she shared many happy years and raised two sons, Jerry and Maury;  
11 the couple lived in Amarillo for a time but eventually settled in  
12 Waco, where they established a home-building company that later  
13 evolved into a successful mortgage business; and

14           WHEREAS, Mrs. Harris was a valued and active member of the  
15 Waco community for nearly half a century, and she shared her time  
16 with a number of worthwhile groups, including Temple Rodef Sholom;  
17 after her husband's death in 1986, she moved to Houston to be closer  
18 to family; and

19           WHEREAS, Known for her courage, wisdom, and insight, Anne  
20 Harris lived a full and generous life, and she will forever be  
21 remembered with deep admiration and affection by all who had the  
22 good fortune to know her; now, therefore, be it
