

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Residents of the Rio Grande Valley joined together
2 May 1-3, 2011, to celebrate the inaugural McAllen Book Fair,
3 organized by Oscar Moreno; and

4 WHEREAS, The first event of its kind in McAllen, the Book Fair
5 was held at the local convention center and featured 30 exhibitors,
6 editorial houses, and bookstores; in addition to writers'
7 conferences and book signings, visitors enjoyed poetry readings,
8 storytelling, a short film and musical presentation, and painting
9 workshops; and

10 WHEREAS, The festival was established by Mr. Moreno in an
11 effort to increase the reading audience in South Texas while
12 generating a dialogue between Anglo and Hispanic communities by
13 allowing the exchange of ideas and enriching the culture of the
14 region; he hopes that the festival will become an annual affair; and

15 WHEREAS, Reading can make a tremendous difference in the
16 lives of both children and adults, opening up new, undiscovered
17 worlds and introducing readers to experiences that they would have
18 never otherwise encountered; Oscar Moreno has helped to share this
19 joy with others, and his efforts have truly benefited the people of
20 McAllen; now, therefore, be it

22 Legislature hereby commend Oscar Moreno for hosting the first book
23 fair in the city of McAllen and extend to him sincere best wishes
