1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow felt at
2 the loss of U.S. Marine Corps Corporal Jeffrey Warren Johnson of
3 Tomball, who died on May 11, 2010, at the age of 21; and

4 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment,
5 1st Marine Division, I Marine Expeditionary Force, Corporal Johnson
6 was based at Camp Pendleton, California; he was killed in action
7 while bravely serving his nation in Afghanistan; and

8 WHEREAS, Jeffrey Johnson continued a family tradition of
9 military service by enlisting in the U.S. Marine Corps in July 2007,
10 shortly after graduating from Waller High School; following boot
11 camp, he trained as an antitank assault guided missileman before
12 traveling to Asia for his first deployment; and

13 WHEREAS, Among the military awards conferred on Corporal
14 Johnson were the Purple Heart, the Combat Action Ribbon, the
15 National Defense Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the
16 Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and the Sea Service
17 Deployment Ribbon; and

18 WHEREAS, Known for his wit and sense of humor, Corporal
19 Johnson was an avid hunter, as well as a fan of NASCAR and Ford
20 trucks; after completing his military service, he planned to attend
21 The University of Texas before pursuing his dream of becoming a game
22 warden; and

23 WHEREAS, Jeffrey Johnson was a loving and devoted husband to
24 his wife, Katy, a caring son, and a loyal brother; his family meant

1 the world to him, and he, to them; and

2 WHEREAS, Corporal Jeffrey Johnson embodied the marine corps
3 values of honor, courage, and commitment, and all who knew this
4 brave young Texan will forever remember him with admiration and
5 gratitude; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
7 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of U.S. Marine Corps
8 Corporal Jeffrey Warren Johnson and extend deepest sympathy to the
9 members of his family: to his wife, Katy Anguish; to his father and
10 stepmother, Jerry and Kelly Johnson; to his mother, Dawn Hardwick;
11 to his sisters, Ashtian Bennett and Cassidy Johnson; to his
12 brother, Jason Martin; to his grandmothers, Delores Campbell and
13 Glenda Schneider; to his grandfathers, John Farmer and Jerry Tyner;
14 and to his other relatives and friends; and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be

18 Jeffrey Johnson.
