R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, In a thrilling demonstration of skill and
2 determination, the Round Top-Carmine High School volleyball team
3 claimed the University Interscholastic League 1A state
4 championship with a victory in the title match at Strahan Coliseum
5 in San Marcos on November 20, 2010; and

6 WHEREAS, The Cubettes advanced to the finals after beating
7 Normangee High School in the semifinals in a closely contested
8 battle in which each game was decided by a handful of points; the
9 tournament final against a talented squad from Wink High School was
10 even more contentious; after the Cubettes took the first two games
11 by scores of 25-20 and 27-25, Wink High came back to tie the match
12 with consecutive 25-20 victories; Round Top-Carmine then won the
13 tiebreaker 15-7 by scoring the final eight points; the team closed
14 out the year with a 34-11 record, including victories in its last 18
15 matches; and

16 WHEREAS, Brook Conley, Emily Noak, and Megan Hohlt were named
17 to the All-Tournament Team, and Ms. Hohlt, a freshman, was declared
18 the most valuable player of the championship game; winning with a
19 true team effort, the Cubettes also received vital contributions
20 throughout the year from the other members of the roster: Jessica
21 Bernshausen, Mandi Rudloff, Tori Brooks, Aby Cies, Bailey
22 Dallmeyer, Mariah Newsome, Marissa Hibbeler, Amanda Leppard, and
23 Amber Sternadel; the team managers are Londen Bayer, Adyson Lange,
24 and Emma Leppard; and

1 WHEREAS, This was the fourth state title for the Round
2 Top-Carmine team, which has played in the state final 11 times and
3 has made 16 appearances in the state tournament; this notable
4 legacy has been overseen by head coach Tanya Nygrin, who has guided
5 the Cubettes for 25 years; and

6 WHEREAS, Winning a state title is the result of countless
7 hours of hard work and an enduring commitment to excellence, and the
8 members of the Round Top-Carmine volleyball team may take
9 justifiable pride in this exceptional achievement; now, therefore,
10 be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
12 Legislature hereby congratulate the Round Top-Carmine High School
13 volleyball team on winning the 2010-2011 University
14 Interscholastic League 1A state championship and extend to the
