1 WHEREAS, Area residents are gathering at Sugar Land Memorial
2 Park on Memorial Day 2011 to pay tribute to those who have given
3 their lives in service to the United States of America; and

4 WHEREAS, In a tradition dating back more than a century, the
5 last Monday in May of each year is set aside as a time to demonstrate
6 our respect and admiration for the United States armed forces and to
7 remember the legions of the fallen; this occasion resonates with
8 special meaning at a time when many of our sons and daughters and
9 husbands and wives are currently engaged in conflicts in distant
10 lands; countless servicemen and servicewomen have experienced the
11 loss of a fellow American firsthand, and all our service members and
12 their families understand the true meaning of sacrifice; and

14 individuals whose love of country leads them to military service,
15 and on Memorial Day communities encourage their citizens to show
16 their unwavering support; at its ceremony, the city of Sugar Land is
17 providing patriotic postcards on which participants can express

20 freedom and values are constantly in the thoughts of the loved ones
21 who eagerly await their safe return, the observance of Memorial Day
