2 in the 2011 Moreno/Rangel Legislative Leadership Program, and  
3 during the 82nd Legislative Session, she has ably served her fellow  
4 Texans as an aide in the office of the Mexican American Legislative  
5 Caucus; and

6           WHEREAS, Sponsored by the Mexican American Legislative  
7 Leadership Foundation, the program offers outstanding university  
8 students and recent graduates an opportunity to serve as full-time  
9 policy interns and gain experience working with the Texas  
10 Legislature; and

11           WHEREAS, A first-generation Mexican American whose parents  
12 are from the states of Nuevo Leon and Coahuila, Irma Aguirre was  
13 taught at a young age to value education and graduated sixth in her  
14 class from Mission High School; she went on to earn a bachelor's  
15 degree in bilingual education from The University of Texas at  
16 Austin; and

17           WHEREAS, Ms. Aguirre then returned to Mission to teach, and  
18 her experiences in the classroom convinced her of the necessity of  
19 sound educational policy and procedure and motivated her to apply  
20 to the Moreno/Rangel program; and

21           WHEREAS, Over the course of her tenure with the Mexican  
22 American Legislative Caucus, Ms. Aguirre has been of great  
23 assistance to the members of the group, while acquiring knowledge  
24 of issues facing citizens of the Lone Star State; she has performed

1 her duties as a legislative aide with skill, perseverance, and  
2 dedication, and she may indeed look forward to a rewarding future;
