3 May 27, 2011, bringing to a close a remarkable 55-year career as a  
4 teacher; and

5           WHEREAS, Ms. Cleveland began teaching in 1956 in Lamesa and  
6 then joined the Abilene ISD; she taught at several schools,  
7 including Reagan, Bonham, and Lee Elementary, before becoming a  
8 special education consulting teacher, and over the 51 years that  
9 she has spent in the district, she has earned the admiration of  
10 students, parents, and fellow educators alike for her caring,  
11 dedicated manner; and

12           WHEREAS, A leader in her profession and community, Ms.  
13 Cleveland is president of Education Abilene and a former member of  
14 the board of directors for the Texas State Teachers Association; in  
15 addition, she has been a member of the National Education  
16 Association and Delta Kappa Gamma Society International; she has  
17 volunteered her time to support the Rape Crisis Center and the  
18 Abilene Philharmonic, and she is also a valued congregant at  
19 Westminster Presbyterian Church; and

20           WHEREAS, Known for her unwavering commitment to her students,  
21 Andy Cleveland has made a positive difference in the lives of  
22 countless young Texans and their families, and it is appropriate to  
23 take this opportunity to honor her; now, therefore, be it
