1 WHEREAS, Wyman Meinzer is being inducted into the Texas
2 Heroes Hall of Honor at the Frontier Times Museum in Bandera on July
3 23, 2011, the National Day of the American Cowboy; and

4 WHEREAS, Founded in 1933, the museum houses the Western
5 memorabilia collection of J. Marvin Hunter, the publisher of
6 *Frontier Times* magazine; this year's Hall of Honor ceremony
7 recognizes the pioneering spirit, strength of character, and
8 contributions to Texas culture of one posthumous inductee and four
9 living legends; and

10 WHEREAS, Designated by the legislature as the Texas State
11 Photographer for the year 1997, Wyman Meinzer has traveled
12 throughout the state, capturing the beauty of its landscape and the
13 distinct cultures of its people; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Meinzer's sweeping and powerful images have been
15 published in more than 20 books, including *Between Heaven and*
16 *Texas*, *Contemporary Ranches of Texas*, and *Working Dogs of Texas*;
17 his work illustrates the state's natural beauty and preserves its
18 grandeur for future generations; and

19 WHEREAS, This talented artist's achievements have greatly
20 enhanced the richness and diversity of Texas culture, and he may
21 indeed take pride in this special recognition from the Frontier
22 Times Museum; now, therefore, be it
