R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Residents of Missouri City have greatly benefited  
2 from the dedicated leadership of Don Smith since he was elected to  
3 the city council; and

4           WHEREAS, During his tenure in municipal government, Mr. Smith  
5 has ably guided the city with an eye to the future, and his
