1 WHEREAS, The city of Rosenberg has greatly benefited from the
2 dedicated leadership of the Honorable Joe M. Gurecky, who has
3 served the community as mayor since 1999; and

4 WHEREAS, The longest-serving mayor in the city's history,
5 Mayor Gurecky was elected to represent District 4 on the city
6 council in 1995 and became mayor four years later; he is a
7 third-generation resident of Rosenberg who worked as a
8 manufacturing manager at Baroid Industrial Drilling Projects for
9 more than 25 years before founding Gurecky Manufacturing Service,
10 Inc., in 1983; he has also farmed and raised cattle in Fort Bend
11 County for four decades; and

12 WHEREAS, Joe Gurecky has been active in many civic
13 organizations, serving as a director of the OakBend Medical Center,
14 the chair of the Holy Rosary Catholic School capital campaign, the
15 president of the planning and zoning commission, and a member of the
16 board of regents of Texas State Technical College; in addition, he
17 was named the businessperson of the year in 2002 by the local
18 chamber of commerce and he is a life member of the Fort Bend County
19 Fair Association; in all his endeavors, he enjoys the love and
20 support of his wife, Doris; and

21 WHEREAS, Each day, public servants improve the quality of
22 life for their fellow citizens in innumerable ways, and the efforts
23 of Joe Gurecky as mayor and as a city councilman have helped to make
24 Rosenberg an even better place in which to live and work; now,

1 therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
3 Legislature hereby honor Mayor Joe M. Gurecky for his many years of
4 service to the citizens of Rosenberg and extend to him sincere best
5 wishes for continued happiness; and, be it further

6 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
7 prepared for Mayor Gurecky as an expression of high regard by the
8 Texas House of Representatives.
