- 14 along with Robert Brown, provided the offensive firepower in the
- 15 championship contest, driving in two runs apiece while winning
- 16 pitcher Scott Hays tossed six scoreless innings; the Tornados won
- 17 by a score of 6-4 to claim the school's second ASC crown and an
- 18 invitation to the National Collegiate Athletic Association
- 19 Division III Tournament; and

- 21 record 30 victories against 15 losses, 11 members of the squad were
- 22 accorded All-ASC West Division honors; in addition to receiving the
- 23 Player of the Year award, Collin Janssen was named to the first team

- 1 Mr. Butschek was chosen as the Pitcher of the Year and was named to
- 2 the first team; also receiving a first team nod was Matt McManemin,

- 4 team; Mr. Beasley, Mr. Brown, Mr. Ullmann, Colton Gommert, C. J.
- 5 Riojas, and Bryant Hernandez received honorable mention accolades;
