R E S O L U T I O N

4 years; and

6 Choice, an alternative school for at-risk students in the
7 Nacogdoches Independent School District, since 1991; he teaches
8 English and language arts to children in the 8th through 12th
9 grades, employing a self-paced curriculum and accelerated learning
10 techniques to help students who have struggled in traditional
11 schools; and

12 WHEREAS, Deeply dedicated to the youth in his classes, Mr.
13 Herrington has served not only as a teacher but as a mentor and, at
14 times, a father figure, helping to guide his students through times
15 of extreme adversity while encouraging them to strive for a better
16 future; determined that they always have someone they could turn
17 to, he has kept in touch via phone and Facebook, called on them in
18 their homes, and even become a licensed minister in order to visit
19 students who were hospitalized or incarcerated; and

8 to his students, and his hard work and diligence have helped improve
