1 WHEREAS, Demonstrating great skill and determination, the
2 boys' swimming and diving team of Carroll High School in Southlake
3 won the University Interscholastic League 5A state championship
4 with an outstanding performance at the state meet on February 18 and
5 19, 2011; and

6 WHEREAS, Facing the best talent in the state at The
7 University of Texas Swim Center in Austin, the Dragons scored an
8 impressive 255 points, beating runner-up Conroe High School by a
9 margin of 74; and

10 WHEREAS, Bryce Klein placed first in diving with a score of
11 562.75, a new school record; another key to the state title triumph
12 was Carroll High's fine efforts in the relay events, with the
13 400-meter freestyle team of Ted Singley, John Ausdenmoore, Ryan
14 Walker, and Connor Nolan placing third and the 200-meter freestyle
15 squad of Mr. Singley, Mr. Ausdenmoore, Curtis Goss, and John
16 Rematta placing fourth; moreover, Mr. Nolan, Mr. Goss, Mr.
17 Ausdenmoore, and Mr. Walker finished fifth in the 200-meter medley
18 relay, setting another school record; all of these swimmers also
19 took part in individual events, as did Jonathan Roberts, who was
20 eighth in the 500-meter freestyle; highlights included the
21 second-place showing by Mr. Nolan in the 200-meter freestyle and
22 the strong swims in the 500-meter freestyle by Mr. Singley and Mr.
23 Nolan, who finished second and third, respectively; and

24 WHEREAS, Winning a state championship represents the

1 culmination of countless hours of hard work and an enduring
2 commitment to excellence, and these talented student-athletes and
3 their coach, Kevin Murphy, may take justifiable pride in this
4 accomplishment; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
6 Legislature hereby congratulate the Carroll High School boys'
7 swimming and diving team on winning the 2010-2011 UIL 5A state
8 championship and extend to its members sincere best wishes for
9 continued success; and, be it further

10 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
11 prepared for the team as an expression of high regard by the Texas
12 House of Representatives.
