1 WHEREAS, A skilled group of athletes brought the 2011 season
2 to a triumphant conclusion as the boys' golf team of Lake Travis
3 High School captured the 2011 University Interscholastic League 4A
4 state title with an exceptional performance at the Jimmy Clay Golf
5 Course in Austin on May 9 and 10; and

6 WHEREAS, The Cavaliers posted an overall score in the state
7 tournament of 20-over-par 596, besting their closest competitor by
8 7 strokes; and

9 WHEREAS, The Lake Travis team was led by Joe Beck III, who
10 shot a 73-70-143 to become the 4A individual champion; Tayler
11 Termeer finished two strokes behind Mr. Beck, tying another golfer
12 for the tournament's second-best score, and he claimed the silver
13 medal after a playoff; Klein Klotz finished fifth with 148, while
14 Austin Sholtis shot 160 and Brandon Pederson totaled 161; and

15 WHEREAS, In winning their school's first golf championship
16 since 1997, the Cavaliers were guided by head coach Randy Morris and
17 assistant coach Eric Henson; and

18 WHEREAS, Through hard work and an enduring commitment to
19 excellence, the Lake Travis High School boys' golf team reached the
20 pinnacle of success during the 2011 season, and these dedicated
21 student-athletes may take justifiable pride in this
22 accomplishment; now, therefore, be it
