1 WHEREAS, The city of Plano lost an admired civic leader with 2 the passing of former mayor James Wyatt Edwards on May 13, 2011, at 3 the age of 73; and

WHEREAS, Born on September 6, 1937, Jim Edwards was the son of 4 5 Margaret and Wyatt Edwards; he served two terms as mayor beginning in 1978 and worked with H. Ross Perot to bring the headquarters of 6 7 EDS, JC Penney, and Frito-Lay to Plano; in addition, he played key roles in the approval of Collin Creek Mall, the extension of the 8 Dallas North Tollway, and the securing of funds for the Bush 9 Tollway; he was the first chair of the Dallas Area Rapid Transit 10 11 board and was a founding board member of the Collin County Community 12 College District; moreover, he served as director of external relations for the nonprofit organization Heart of a Champion and 13 14 held numerous other leadership roles; his most recent initiative, the "Changing Hearts Project," benefited combat veterans and their 15 families; and 16

WHEREAS, Mr. Edwards enjoyed a long career in higher 17 education administration; early in his career, he headed the 18 accounting department at Texas Christian University, and he went on 19 to become executive vice president of Dallas Baptist University, 20 21 head of the MBA program at Southern Methodist University, and president and chancellor of William Carey College in Hattiesburg, 22 23 Mississippi; he was active in politics as well, working on the George W. Bush campaign in 2000 and the Mike Huckabee campaign in 24

1 2008, and he was a delegate to the 2008 Republican National
