WHEREAS, After the war, Mr. O'Connor 9 attended Baylor University and received a degree in chemistry in 1949; he enlisted 10 11 in the U.S. Air Force the following year, serving as a second 12 lieutenant with the 17th Bomb Wing of the 5th Air Force in Korea; in 1951, while at James Connally Air Force Base, he met Nancy Rohan, a 13 14 longtime Waco resident, and they soon married and went on to share nearly 50 years together before her passing and to welcome three 15 16 children, George, Kelly, and Kathleen, into their family; and

WHEREAS, Mr. O'Connor enjoyed a notable career in the wholesale supply business as president of the Rohan and William Cameron companies in Waco and the CertainTeed Corporation in Pennsylvania, and he was recognized for his professional achievements in *The Wall Street Journal* in 1980; he retired in 1988; and
