10 WHEREAS, An outgoing individual who delighted in the company
11 of her friends, Mrs. Skinner worked as an interior decorator and
12 volunteered at the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd in Corpus
13 Christi and at charitable organizations in the area; she married
14 Scott Skinner in 1960, and the couple enjoyed a number of years
15 together until Mr. Skinner's passing; she moved to Waco in 2000,
16 joining St. Alban's Episcopal Church and the St. Alban's Guild and
17 helping at the Fuzzy Friends Rescue shelter; and

18 WHEREAS, While the passing of Bette Skinner has brought great
19 sorrow to her family and friends, she has left behind a legacy that
20 will long be treasured by all those who held her dear; now,
