15 fine woodwork and ability to fix nearly anything; he enjoyed a

19 Bellmead; and

20           WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known Julius Backus  
21 will remember the way he touched their lives with his kindness,  
22 generosity, and compassion, and he will forever hold a treasured  
23 place in their hearts; now, therefore, be it
